The Global Network Engineering Program for International Students (GNEPIS) at the University of Fukui provides an opportunity for international students to study various fields of engineering. English is the primary language for the instruction in the courses and for research supervision. This is a call for applications to a three-year Doctoral Course beginning in the academic year of 2010, i.e. beginning on October 1, 2010.

Among the qualified applicants, the University of Fukui will recommend a few exceptional students to the Japanese Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (Monbukagakusho in Japanese) as 3-year Monbukagakusho scholarship candidates.

For the details of the Monbukagakusho Scholarship, please refer to the attached document "Information about the Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho) scholarship for the 2010 Global Network Engineering Program for International Students (GNEPIS) at the University of Fukui".

**2. Term of the program**

This is a 3-year program starting on October 1, 2010.

**3. Qualifications for application**

It is required that applicants have no legal limitation or hindrance to being admitted to the university under "the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act" of Japan, and that they comply with the following conditions.

**(1) Eligibility**

Applicants must be non-Japanese nationals residing outside Japan.

**(2) Nationality**

Applicants who wish to apply for the Monbukagakusho scholarship nominated by the university must be nationals of countries that are recognized by the Japanese Government as of April 1, 2010, which are the countries in Asia (excluding Taiwan and Democratic People's Republic of Korea), the Middle and Near East, Africa, Oceania, North America, Central and South America, and Europe.

However, apart from the Monbukagakusho Scholarship, this restriction does not apply.

**(3) Age**

Applicants for the Monbukagakusho Scholarship must be 34 years of age or younger as of April 1, 2010 (The birth date must be April 2, 1975 or later).

**(4) Academic career**

Applicants must qualify for one of the six categories stated below:

- ① Those who have a Master Degree or a Professional Degree (Article 5-2, Degree Rule of Monbusho Ordinance No.9, 1953), or will be able to receive it by the end of September, 2010.
- ② Those who have a degree from a foreign institution that is equivalent to a Japanese Master Degree or will be able to receive it by the end of September, 2010.
- ③ Those who have or will receive a Master Degree or a Professional Degree in Japan by the end of September, 2010, after finishing the subjects of correspondence education programs that are offered by foreign institutions.
- ④ Those who have or will receive a degree which is equivalent to a Japanese master or professional degree by the end of September, 2010 from a foreign educational institution in Japan which is designated by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sport, Science and Technology.
- ⑤ Those who have obtained special recognition from the Japanese Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology. (Refer to the Monbusho Notification 118, 1989)
- ⑥ Those who are 24 years of age or older and are considered to have academic ability equivalent to a Master Degree or higher through an individual entrance examination by the University of Fukui, Graduate School.

**(5) Language proficiency**

The English proficiency should be sufficient to keep up with the courses offered in this program.

**(6) When to arrive in Japan**

The date of arrival in Japan must be

- (a) Between October 1 and October 6, 2010, for the applicants awarded a Monbukagakusho scholarship;
- (b) Before September 29, 2010, for the privately funded applicants.

**(7) Other**

Applicants who fall under any of the categories stated below will not be accepted as candidates for the Monbukagakusho Scholarship nominated by a university.

- ① Military personnel and employee from military institutions.
- ② Applicants who are not able to arrive in Japan on the specified date.
- ③ Applicants who was a recipient of the Monbukagakusho Scholarship in the past three years.
- ④ Applicants who will receive a scholarship from an institution (including government institutions of the students' country of origin) other than the Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho).
- ⑤ Applicants who are applying more than one school, or who have applied for the Monbukagakusho Scholarship by embassy recommendation simultaneously.
- ⑥ Applicants who wish fieldwork outside Japan.

**4.1 Application and Deadlines**

**(1) Submission period**

The arrival date of the application material at the University of Fukui must be

- (a) Between February 1 and February 19, 2010, for applicants who wish to apply for a Monbukagakusho scholarship;

Note: The application for a Monbukagakusho scholarship is limited to only one organization at a time. If an application is submitted to the University of Fukui, the applicant cannot at the same time submit another application to any university in Japan or any Japanese Government scholarship.

- (b) Between April 1 and April 30, 2010, for the applicants who apply as a privately funded student.

**(2) Supervising professor**

Prior to the submission, the applicant is requested to choose his/her supervising professor at the University of Fukui and to contact him/her to discuss his/her research topic.

**(4) Application documents (All must be written either in English or in Japanese)**

① Application Form for Admission

The student him/herself must fill out the designated form 1/3, 2/3, 3/3.

② Application Form for the 3-year Monbukagakusho Scholarship

The student him/herself must fill out the designated form

\*Application for Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho:MEXT) Scholarship=Print (double-sided) and submit (3 sheets)

③ Certificate of Health

It must be prepared on a given form and issued by a medical doctor, not more than 6 months prior to the date of the application.

④ Certificate of Graduation or Prospective Graduation

The Certificate must be issued by the university attended most recently (a diploma, a graduation prospect, or a statement of the degree attained). In the case of those who have graduated from schools other than universities, a document certifying or describing that the school he/she graduated from is equivalent to master program must be attached.

⑤ Transcripts of Academic Record

Transcripts issued in English both from the undergraduate university and by the graduate school attended. The Grade Point Average (GPA), an explanation of the classification (e.g. ABC) and the academic performance standing (th / students) are required on the transcripts. The academic performance needs to be in an upper most class.

⑥ A Certificate of the Citizenship or the Country of Origin

A certificate of citizenship or the country of origin, such as the census register or the citizen's register.

⑦ A Letter of Recommendation

Applicants who seek the Monbukagakusho Scholarship with a recommendation by the University of Fukui must submit a letter of recommendation written for the President of the University of Fukui by the Dean of the Faculty or College most recently attended. The other applicants may instead submit a letter of recommendation issued by the chairman of the department most recently attended, by the supervising professor of his/her Master Thesis, or by his/her supervisor or by somebody who knows the applicant well in case that the applicant holds a position in an academic institution or company.

⑧ ID Photographs

Four ID photographs (hatless, head shot), 4.5 cm x 3.5 cm in size, taken within six months prior to this application, with the applicant's name and nationality on the reverse side of each photo. Two should be attached to the Application Form and the other two should be enclosed therein.

⑨ Abstract of the Master Degree Thesis

A summary of the Master Degree Thesis must be enclosed.

⑩ Certification of Language Ability and Specialty

A copy of the certification of language ability (i.e. TOEFL or TOEIC score) must be enclosed. As a certification for the applicant's specialty, copies of all published journal papers and the papers presented at international symposiums/ or domestic meetings must be enclosed.

**(5) Evaluation fee: 30,000 Japanese yen**

The applicants for a Monbukagakusho Scholarship will be exempted from this evaluation fee. However, when the application for the Monbukagakusho Scholarship is rejected, and if the applicant hopes to apply as a privately funded student instead, the evaluation fee is required. All applicants as a privately funded student need to send the examination fee of 30,000 yen by an international postal money order etc. (it needs to be payable on demand) to the Admissions Division of University of Fukui.

**4.2 Pre-evaluation of the Qualification for Application**

If the application is made based on an academic career ⑥ in page 2, the pre-evaluation of the qualification is requested prior to the submission. The applicant is suggested to contact the aforementioned Admissions Division, through the supervising professor.

## 5. Examination

Admission will be granted based on the examination of the submitted documents. Nominated applicants for a Monbukagakusho Scholarship will be required to participate in an Internet Interview by three faculty members including their prospective supervisor.

## 6. Notification of Acceptance

The applicants for a Monbukagakusho Scholarship will be notified of the results of the examination by postal mail in the second ten days of April. The final decision of the Monbukagakusho scholarship recipients will be made by the Monbukagakusho, and the results will be sent by postal mail in the first ten days of August.

The privately funded applicants will be notified of the results of the examination by postal mail in the second ten days of May.

## 7. Admission Procedures and School Fee

### (1) Admission procedures must be completed

(a) By October 6, 2010, for those who are awarded a Monbukagakusho scholarship;

(b) By September 30, 2010, for privately funded students.

If the admission procedures are not completed, the admission will be cancelled.

### (2) School fee

Admission fee: 282,000 yen

Tuition for the first year: 535,800 yen

The tuition may increase during the program.

The admission fee (282,000 yen) and the first winter semester tuition (267,900 yen) must be paid in full upon entrance.

(a) Monbukagakusho scholarship recipients are exempted from both admission and tuition fees.

(b) Privately funded students who request financial support for living expenses should contact their supervising professors at the University of Fukui. The graduate school of engineering has a fund to support a part of living expenses corresponding to admission and tuition fees.

## 8. Other Instructions

(1) Application documents must be typed in English or in Japanese on A4 size sheets. If it is not possible to type use a black ink or a ball-point pen to fill out the form in block letters. For documents in languages other than English, English translations must be attached.

(2) Incomplete applications or applications arriving after the deadline will not be processed.

(3) Once application documents and evaluation fees are received, they are not returned. No changes will be allowed in the submitted documents. Change of home address (contact place) must be reported immediately.

(4) Both scholarship-awarded and privately funded students are advised to contact their supervising professors and to discuss their research program before coming to Japan. English language will be used for the education and research with the supervisor, but also Japanese will be required for daily life. The students are strongly recommended to learn Japanese conversation in home country.

**Information about the Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho) scholarship for the  
2010 Global Network Engineering Program for International Students (GNEPIS) of  
University of Fukui**

**1. The scholarship includes the followings.**

**(1) Amount of scholarship**

A student will receive a monthly scholarship of 155,000 yen. (This amount may change.)

**(2) Tuition and fees**

Tuition, enrollment and entrance examination fees are paid by the Monbukagakusho.

**(3) Travel expenses**

① Travel to Japan

Travel expenses will be paid, in the form of economy class air tickets, from the international airport nearest to the students' city of residence in their country to one of the international airports nearest to University of Fukui (Kansai, Nagoya or Komatsu International Airport).

② Travel from Japan

Upon completing the scholarship tenure and returning to their country by the designated date, travel expenses will be paid, in the form of economy class air tickets, from one of the international airports nearest to University of Fukui (Kansai, Nagoya or Komatsu International Airport) to the international airport nearest to their city of residence in their country.

**(4) Scholarship tenure**

3 years , from October 2010 to September 2013.

**2. Notes**

**(1) The scholarship award will be withdrawn in any one of the following instances:**

① If the grantee has made false statements on his/her application.

② If the grantee has violated any article on his/her pledge to the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology. The pledge must be submitted after being accepted as a Monbukagakusho scholar.

③ If the grantee has been subject to disciplinary action or has been found to have no promise for academic achievement by University of Fukui. If the grantee is absent from school for a lengthy period of time without permission, the scholarship may also be withdrawn.

④ If the grantee has quit a university, or changed to another universities.

⑤ If the grantee's status of residence has changed to another from College Student.

⑥ If the grantee has received a scholarship from an institution other than the Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho).

**(2) After arriving in Japan, Monbukagakusho scholarship recipients are not allowed to receive any Japanese Language Education from universities other than University of Fukui or to change the university.**

**(3) If a student was previously a Monbukagakusho scholar, it is necessary for him/her to have at least 3 years of experience in teaching and research after returning to his/her home country.**

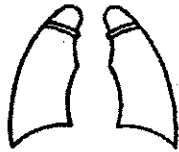
